Plans of few
Indo Students
in China

1. ONLY 20 OF ALL THE INDONESIAN STUDENTS IN CHINA IN EARLY JUNE 1966 CAN BE CONSIDERED AS FAVORING THE CURRENT INDONESIAN GOVERNMENT. THESE 20 DEFINITELY PLAN TO RETURN TO DJAKARTA AT THE CLOSE OF THE CURRENT SCHOOL TERM. BUT INDONESIAN AUTHORITIES DO NOT INTEND TO INFORM THE CHINESE COMMUNIST GOVERNMENT THE STUDENTS PLAN TO LEAVE UNTIL 15 JUNE;



THEY DO NOT WANT THE CHINESE TO CUT OFF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE STUDENTS BEFORE THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.



2. ACCORDING TO THE STUDENTS IN CONTACT WITH THE INDONESIAN EMBASSY IN PEKING, BETWEEN EIGHT AND TEN STUDENTS WHO ARE OPPOSED TO THE PRESENT INDONESIAN REGIME ARE CONSIDERING JOINING THE GROUP WHICH PLANS TO RETURN TO INDONESIA. THE EMBASSY EXPECTS THERE WILL BE FIGHTING BETWEEN THE TWO FACTIONS IF IN FACT SOME OPPOSED TO THE GOVERNMENT DO GO ALONG WITH THE OTHERS.

3. MONEY FOR TRANSPORTATION AND ACCOMMODATIONS OF THE STUDENTS RETURNING TO INDONESIA WILL BE ADVANCED BY THE INDONESIAN CONSULATE GENERAL IN HONG KONG. ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR THE STUDENTS TO FLY VIA GARUDA AIRLINES FROM HONG KONG TO DJAKARTA IN LATE JULY.
